LIVING COSTS IN GERMANY

The total monthly average expenses of a student in Germany are between 700 and 1200 Euro

- Average monthly expenses for rent: 350 - 750 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for insurance: 35 - 115 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for food: 250 - 350 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for telephone and Internet: 40 - 60 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for transports and others: 50 - 150 Euro



BUDGET



Students who want to study in Germany need about **20,000 Euros** for this Project.

Opening a bank account in Germany	11,250 Euro
German Language	2,500-3,000 Euro
Costs for applying	1,500-2,500 Euro
Cash money for Germany	2,000 Euro
Extras	600-1,600 Euro

GERMAN UNIVERSITIES

- Germany universities are recognized internationally.

Academic Ranking:

- Six universities are in the top 100 universities in the world.
- 18 of the top 200.
- 50 in the Top 500.
- Most of the German universities are public institutions,
No tuition fees.

English programs: mostly offered for WS
German programs: for summer and winter semester

CONDITIONS

English programs

- Course language 100 % in English
- Requirements (English program)
- Toefel over 79 GPA over 3 from 4 (Internet Based) or IELTS over 6.5
- German Level: A1 or till B1
- GRE test is strongly recommended

German programs

- Course language 100% in German
- Requirements GPA over 2,1 from 4
- German Level: DSH II or DSH III

Double Language Programm

- Course language 70% English and 30% German.
- IELTS over 6.5 or Toefl over 80 (Internet Base)
- Requirements GPA over 2,8 from 4
- German Level: A2- B2

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- Five courses in German:
A1, A2, B1, B2, and C1
- Each course consists of 100 – 200 hours.
- Finishing A1 – B1 with WTG Academy from your home country.
- Finishing B2 – C1 in Germany.

To enter the university:

- DSH –Exam over 67%
- DAF 4*4
- Telc C1

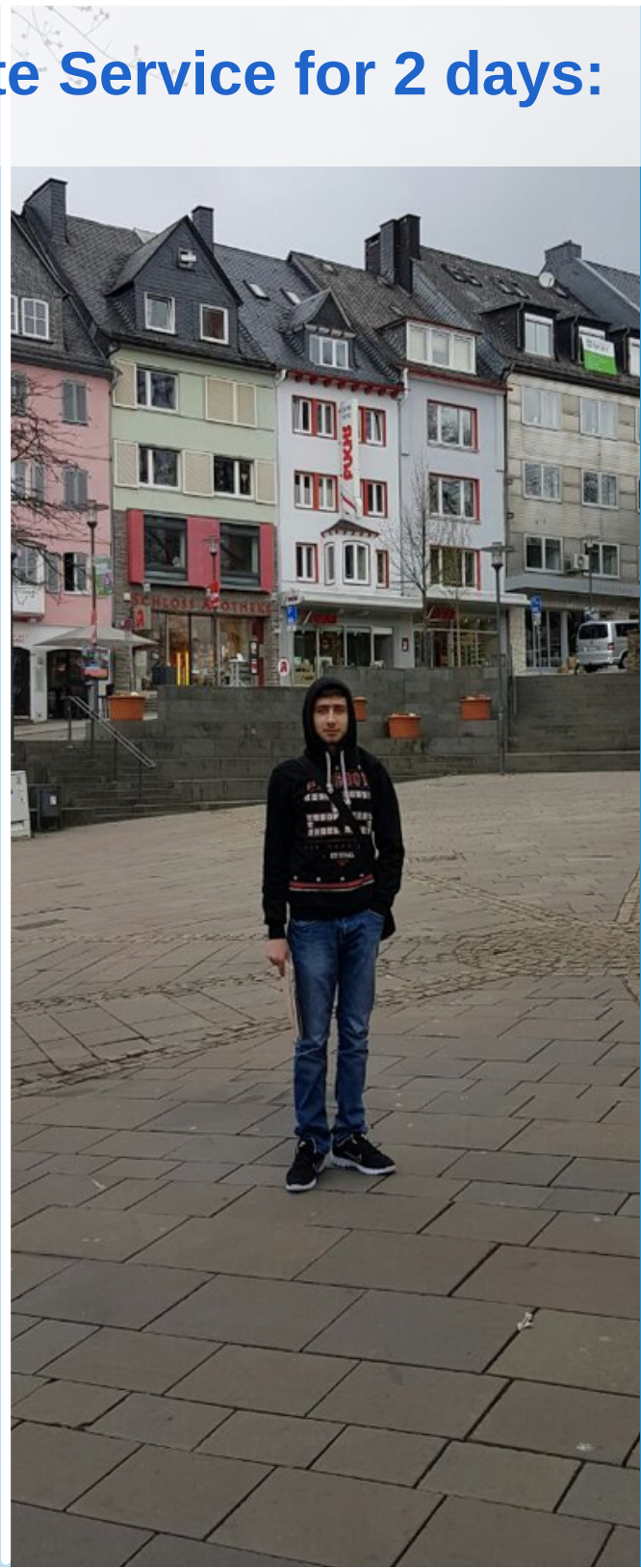
