# LIVING COST IN GERMANY



**The total monthly average expenses of an employee in Germany are between 700 and 1200 Euro.**

- Average monthly expenses for rent: 350-750 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for insurance: 35 -115 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for food: 250-350 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for telephone and Internet: 40-60 Euro
- Average monthly expenses for transports and others: 50-150 Euro

## Numbers and facts:

- 107 universities and TU with 1,7 Mio. students
- 276 universities of applied science with 930 thousand students
- 52 Kunst-, Film- und Musikhochschulen with 35 thousand students
- 125 private universities 24,6 thousand students



# PROCEDURE AND DURATION OF MEDICAL STUDIES



Depending on the Federal State  
and university: 12 to 13  
semesters

The Course of medical studies is fundamentally  
divided into three parts

## Pre-clinic:

- 4 Semesters
- Internship: 3 months
- 1st medical examination (Physikum)

## Clinic:

- 5-10 Semesters
- Clerkship (4 months )
- 2nd medical examination (Hammer exam)

## Practical Year:

11th and 12th Semester  
3rd medical examination



# REQUIREMENTS FOR STUDYING MEDICINE IN GERMANY

- Finished Secondary Education
- Life Sciences Branch or Equivalent (Extensive knowledge of Biology, Chemistry, Physics)
- Grade:  $\geq 17$
- **Language requirements:**
  - English programs: Level B2 IELTS 6.5 or equivalent
  - German programs: DSH III

- Perform TestAS.

### **Studienkolleg, should:**

- Study the German language.
- Study the M-course in Germany.
- Perform TestAS.
- Apply to medical universities.

# GERMAN LANGUAGE FOR STUDYING MEDICINE IN GERMANY

## **German Medicine Program: Direct:**

Five courses in German: A1, A2, B1, B2 and C1

- Each course consists of 100 – 200 hours
- Finishing A1 – B1 in Home Country
- Finishing B2 – C1 in Germany
- To enter the university: DSH I, II, III
- Scoring  $\geq 87$

## **German Medicine Program: Studienkolleg:**

- Finishing A1 – B1 / B2 in Home Country
- Courses will be taken within the M-course

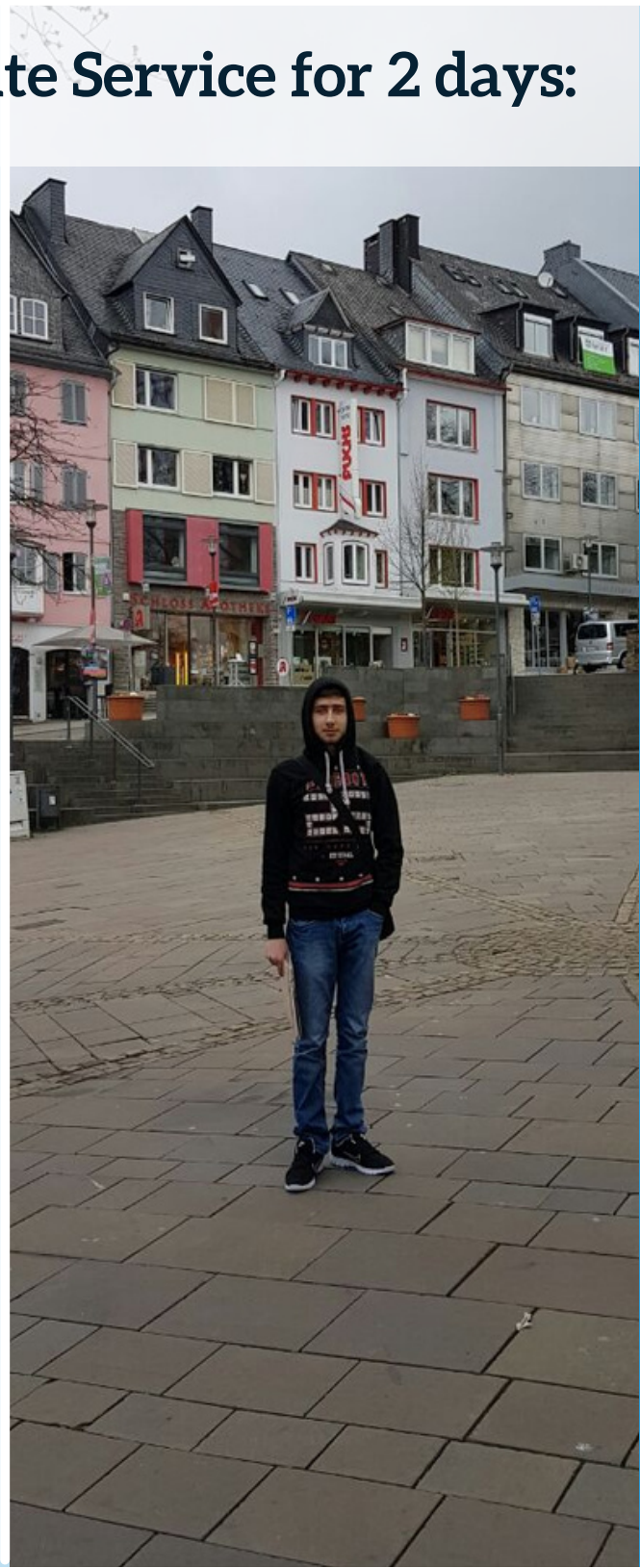
